700 MHz Statement of Requirements Schedule

October 22nd:

A high level mapping of the Project MESA functional requirements to the existing NPSTC BBWG requirements for 700MHz will be delivered to the NPSTC BBWG. This mapping will be used to scope the gap analysis

October 23rd and 24th:

A meeting, over two days, will be held in Boulder, CO made up of the participants from the NPSTC Broadband Working Group. This meeting will walk through the requirements created specifically for the 700MHz work as directed by NPSTC and the PSST.

October 26th:

A draft of the 700 MHz requirements document will be delivered to the public safety community based on the output of the NPSTC BBWG.

October 26th – November 7th:

A vetting process will be gone through whereby the public safety community will comment on the 700 MHz requirements document, for incorporation into the final deliverable. Comment resolution will be addressed by a group of public safety SME's. At the same time, the Project MESA SoR and Functional Requirements will be directly mapped to the 700MHz requirements. Where gaps are discovered, those gaps will be addressed in the 700 MHz document. Every effort will be made to incorporate those gaps into the document that will be delivered on Nov. 7th.

November 7th:

A final version of the 700 MHz requirements will be delivered to the PSST.

November 28:

A pre-bidders conference will be held, leveraging the 700 MHz requirements delivered to the PSST.

November 28th – TBD:

Any gaps between the Project MESA requirements and the 700 MHz requirements that were not incorporated into the November 7th document will be incorporated into the 700 MHz requirements through a public safety SME process.

TBD – 6 months later:

The Network Sharing Agreement will be developed, using a variety of input, amongst which will be the 700 MHz requirements document.
